This will be a 5 round Swiss System tournament where all the players will play 5 rounds. Divisions will be determined by number of players registered in each grade. To start we will have Elementary and Jr. High/High School sections. G/40

The second tournament will be an open tournament for all girl chess players, Kindergarten through 12th Grade, who would like a chance to be the Colorado Representative at this year's Susan Polgar Invitational the summer of 2010. All players must be current registered members with the United States Chess Federation. Tournament type will be determined by the number of registered players, 5 Round Swiss or Round Robin.
