This year's K-1 State Championship will be held on Saturday, February 18. This is a five round Swiss system tournament. All rated and unrated K-1 players are invited. Your K-1 child **does not** need to be a United States Chess Federation member to play. Players will play all 5 rounds. The top 5 players will receive 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> place trophies. All other players will receive participation trophies.

For the main tournament all participants must have a current United States Chess Federation membership (USCF). You will be responsible to have your membership current. You may go to the following URL to acquire or renew your USCF membership:
